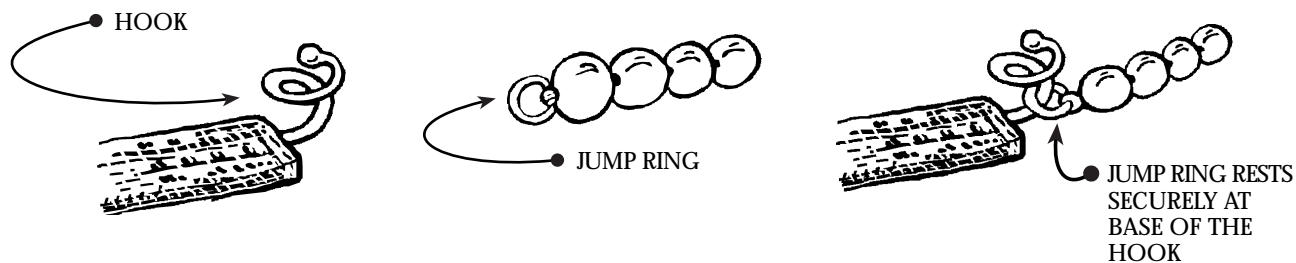


RIBBON CENTERPIECE

Attaching Strands



DIRECTIONS FOR RIGHT HANDER

1. Hold Centerpiece in left hand, facing you, with hooks facing up.
2. Slip jump ring of one strand onto Right double spiral hook. Make sure you slide it around twice, so the jump ring rests at the base of the hook. Slip jump ring of 2nd strand on to the same Right hook.
3. Both strands are resting at the base of the Right hook. With Centerpiece in left hand, use the right hand to twist the 2 strands: the tighter the twist, the shorter the necklace will be.
4. Keeping Centerpiece in left hand, reverse it so the hooks face away from you; the loose ends of the strands are still in your right hand.
5. In front of a mirror, hold the Centerpiece (in left hand) up to your neck; use the right hand to take the strands up the left side of your neck, around the back of your neck and down to your right front.
6. Still holding the Centerpiece in place with left hand, take the shorter strand in right hand and slip the jump ring onto the Right (empty) double spiral hook. Make sure you slide it around twice to rest at the base of the hook.
7. With right hand, take the remaining strand and slip the jump ring onto the Right hook, slide it around and down to the base, so it rests on top of the first jump ring.
8. Adjust the strands so the twists are even.

REMEMBER: The image is reversed in the mirror. Make sure that you “wrap” the jump ring completely “around, down and up” so that it rests at the base of the hook, secure against the woven base of the Centerpiece.
